Solar Eclipse Impact:

Nature responds to the eclipse depending on your location.

For example:

Shadows may look different, any breeze may dissipate, and birds may stop chirping. During a total solar eclipse, some animals may act confused or prepare for sleep. A 10°–15° F drop in temperature is not unusual.

After a total solar eclipse, total daylight is restored in about an hour.

Celestial Spectacle: Witness the 2024 Total Solar Eclipse

Astronomers and skygazers are bracing for the astronomic event of a lifetime. The breathtaking total solar eclipse on Monday, 8 April 2024—is a rare celestial event where the Moon passes between the Earth and the Sun, creating a captivating spectacle. This will be the first total solar eclipse in Ontario since 1979, and the next one is not anticipated until 2099, making this event truly extraordinary. People usually have to travel to the other side of the planet if they want to see a total solar eclipse, but this year, you will have a chance to see it not so far from home. Total solar eclipses are only visible within a narrow path. In order to witness the full eclipse, you must be located in this path

of totality. Nearby Chatham/Kent and Elgin counties lie directly in this path, making them prime viewing locations.

<u>Safety:</u> To ensure a safe viewing experience, it is crucial to use approved solar glasses and filters for cameras and telescopes.

You should never look directly at the Sun. Without protective eyewear, the Sun's radiation can be incredibly damaging. Remember, the weather, and in particular, the clouds, may define the quality of your experience. Don't miss this once-in-a-lifetime display of natures wonders.
